After hearing from Deacon Joel about his work at the boron mine, our students had the opportunity to see science in action! We were joined by Terri "T" Hacobian, who led a hands-on experiment where students created their own crystals using pipe cleaners, borax, and hot water.

As the borax dissolved in the hot water and then slowly cooled, students watched as crystals began to form and grow—transforming simple materials into something beautiful and intricate. It was an exciting way to explore basic chemistry concepts like solutions, saturation, and crystallization.

More importantly, this activity sparked curiosity and wonder as students observed how God designed the world to function with order and consistency. Through experiences like this, students are not only learning science—they are growing as Adaptive Learners and Persistent Innovators, discovering that learning can be both meaningful and fun.
